OPEN POSITIONS:

FISCAL OFFICER — On November 6, 2017 Renee Hertzfeld tendered her resignation as Fiscal Officer for the Township with an effective end date of November 30, 2017.

The Waterville Township Board of Trustees is accepting letters with resumes from township residents who are interested in filling the vacancy of Township Fiscal Officer. The Fiscal Officer is the records keeper and financial officer of the township, responsible for the management of all financial records, accounts and transactions including paying bills, issuing checks and payroll. Duties include annual budgets and appropriations, the annual financial report, filing of Federal, State and Local payroll taxes, Workers' Compensation, OSHA and insurance claims. Candidate must have the qualifications of an elector of Waterville Township, Lucas County, Ohio. Knowledge of modern governmental accounting theory, principles and practices is a plus. This is an appointment to an independently elected public office that would expire in spring 2019 and is subject to re-election pursuant to ORC 503.24. Please note this is an elected and compensated position.

NEXUS UPDATE:

On August 25, 2017 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity under Section 7 of the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct and operate the NEXUS Gas Transmission, LLC (Nexus) Gas Transmission Project. Because of this and along with the Notification to Proceed that was also issued this fall by FERC to NEXUS, initial work has begun on the construction of the pipeline. In Waterville Township we may begin to see surveying along with tree removal. In April or May of next year, construction of the actual pipeline will begin in our area. The targeted completion date for the pipeline is summer 2018. The compressor station site will see initial construction started with fencing, footings, infrastructure and drainage work started. At this time, we have been told the compressor station is targeted to be completely constructed and in service in the second quarter of 2019.

LEAF PICKUP:

Leaf pickup is now underway. Remember to rake your leaves to the edge of the roadway and be sure that no rocks, wood, etc. are in the leaf piles. Residents can check the township website, www.watervilletownship.com, under "Services" to find out when the final pickup date will be for 2017.
