Special Meeting; Fiscal Officer Resignation

November 6, 2017 8:00am

Meeting called to order at 8:05am

Kyle Hertzfeld made a motion to approve the meeting agenda. Keith Moosman seconded.

There were no public comments.

Fiscal Officer, Renee Hertzfeld, requested the Special Meeting to resign her position as Fiscal Officer of Waterville Township. She stated that her leaving the position had nothing to do with the current Board of Trustees. Fiscal Officer Hertzfeld commented the following: that the stress of multiple public records requests and offensive comments directed to her as well as the Trustees was a strain. She also stated that she has worked tirelessly to do the best job possible for the township.

She is happy to have worked with this Board of Trustees, maintenance department personnel and the police department- all of whom work together to provide a safe and healthy community that she is proud to live in. She will help transition the position to the next person.

Trustee Moosman stated his appreciation for everything she has done and that he hates to see her leave. "It will be a big loss for the township."

Trustee Hertzfeld also stated his appreciation for the time she devoted to the position.

Trustee Schneider thanked her for the significant amount of work she has done to advance the fiscal officer position and for the sacrifices she has made to do so.

It was agreed that the position would be posted and a mailing done to residents to inform them of the open position.
